

## Plant Tissue

### **Sample Size: 2 Cups or 1 oz.**

Sample every 2 to 4 weeks from the same variety. Collect recently matured leaves only, just below the growing point. from at least 10 randomly selected plants. For problem diagnosis collect separate samples from both “good” and “bad” areas. This comparison often helps to determine corrective remedies. Air dry samples for one day, place in the paper sack labeled Plant Tissue (drying and use of paper is very important). Write a description of the sample on the bag label.

Complete submittal form and be sure to include any notes regarding symptoms and fertility programs. Retain a copy for your records.

### **Important:**

Do not use plastic bags. Do not include diseased, insect damaged, or Contaminated plant tissue in sample. Always run media analysis in conjunction with tissue analysis.
